1. Principal accounting policies

- (a) Accounting convention
 The accounts are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entitles (effective April 2008). In preparing the accounts the charity follows best practice as laid down in the Statement of Recommended Practice "Accounting and Reporting by Charities" (SORP 2000) issued in October 2000.
- (b) Interest received interest is accounted for in the period in which the charity receives interest from the bank.
- (c) Resources expended Expenditure is included on a payments basis.
- (d) Tangible fixed assets and depreciation
 All assets costing more than £500 are capitalised.

Fixtures and fittings are written off on a reducing balance basis over their estimated useful life at 15% of written down value.

Motor vehicles are written off on a reducing balance basis over their estimated useful life at 25% of written down value.
