OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Objectives and aims

The charity has been established to assist in raising funds for the maintenance and enhancement of sports facilities in Lytham, Lancashire.

The first and current project is the refurbishment and improvement of the changing rooms and other facilities at Lytham Cricket & Sports Club.

Public benefit

The charity raises funds to assist Amateur Sports Clubs which are either Community Amateur Sports Clubs or Members Clubs operating for the provision of sports facilities to the Lytham area of Lancashire

ACHIEVEMENT AND PERFORMANCE

Charitable activities

During the period since formation, the Charity has raised over £30,000 towards new facilities at Lytham Cricket & Sports Club. It is intended to launch a further appeal for funds as soon as the planned buildings receive outline planning permission from the local authority.
