TRUSTEES' REPORT

FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30TH SEPTEMBER 2016

The trustees have pleasure in presenting this report for the year ended 30 September 2016, which has been prepared in accordance with the charitable deed and the recommendations of the Statement of Recommeded Practice - Accounting and Reporting by Charities and complies with applicable law.

The attached accounts are prepared under the "Linking by Uniting Direction" procedure agreed with the Charity Commissioners incorporating the John Phillips Millennium Green Trust for Part VI (accounting) of the Charities Act 2012, which does not remove the separate legal nature of the Millennium Green Trust, the assets of which are only administered on a special trust basis.

Governing Instrument

The Romney Charity

The charity's objects and regulations are governed by charitable deed and the Charities Act 2012. The objects of the charity are given by deed of 1814 and the now amended scheme of 1830, whereby the trustees (Feoffees) are empowered to use the assets under their control for the general benefit of the people of Tetbury. These objects include, in particular, the advancement of education, the relief of poverty and the provision and maintenance of the open areas, recreational spaces and other properties owned by the charity.

The John Phillips Millennium Green Trust

The trust's objects and regulations are governed by the charitable deed and the Charities Act 2012, the main aim being to provide informal leisure amenities for the people of Tetbury.

Principal Policies to Achieve Objectives

It is the aim of the common trustees of both charities to maximise the use of the assets and income under their control, for the benefit of the residents of Tetbury, in full accordance with the specified objects of the respective charities.

Review of Activities

The Romney Charity

The trustees continued to pursue their objective to improve and increase the funding grants made by the charity and this year has seen a substantial rise in the charitable aid distributed. Whilst implementing this objective, work still continued on improving the property assets for the beneficial use of the local community and major projects were completed in the Herd Lane and Cutwell areas, with assessments being undertaken for further renovations on both the Chipping Steps and Market House properties. Over the past few years the trustees have invested major time and effort in maximising their income streams resulting in th current stable and ongoing strength of the charity's financial resources which has enabled the trustees to make substantial commitments to the local community and provide ongoing benefit for the Tetbury residents. A financial summary of the annual results is detailed below which, with the attached notes to the accounts will, it is hoped, provide a detailed picture of the activities undertaken:

Income; £81,875 (2015 : £86,838)

Overall total income fell slightly from last year's record levels but dividend income has improved again £17,762 (2015: £17,078) due to our further investment in COIF income units but rental income has fallen to £39,849 (2015: £41,657) solely from parking fees where ticket sales have decreased, mainly in the 1hr slots reflecting falling local use. We also suffered from reduced Market House bookings £23,899 (2015: £26,340) but we have lost one of our regular traders due to retirement and our efforts will concentrate on attracting othe regular users. Wayleave income returned to its normal levels following the beneficial one off payment received from BT (£795) last year.

Expenditure: £91,741 (2015: £61,629)

As

reported above total charitable grant payments were substantially increased to £26,850 (2015 : £17,351), a commitment we hope to maintain for the foreseeable future. Market House costs rose slightly £17,378 (2015 : £15,124) mainly from safety improvements carried out to the roof space, with improved lighting and access facilities to the external roof area. Additional enhancements were undertaken on the estate properties increasing expenditure to £27,688 (2015 : £17,022) arising from the installation of kerbing to the grass verges in Cutwell (£8,572), which were eroded by increased traffic movements, essential tree felling on Cutwell Green (£5,772) with final renovations to the surface of Herd Lane (£6,118) and safety repairs to the bridge below Berkeley Wood (£1,109). Administration costs rose sharply £11,333 (2015 : £3,837) reflecting the rising cost of administering the charity due to bureacracy, increasing activities due to its improving financial situation and the requirement to refer property issues and other matters to professional advisors. Professional fees amounted to £6,671 (2015 : £755) derived from legal advice on property issues (£1,545) valuation fees (£3,900) on carrying out a revaluation of all our property assets, the total value of which is relected in the charity's reserves, renewing our Trade Mark registration (£544) and updating our website software (£682). The clerk and treasurer's expenses rose to £2,946 (2015 : £1,113) due to the division of the two roles arising from the increased workload.

The John Phillips Millennium Green Trust

The Green is still retained as an informal leisure area for public use and community activities. The charity has no regular income and is maintained by grant aid from The Romney Charity which has agreed to maintain these funding arrangements for the foreseeable future. Operating costs for this current year amounted to £3,588 (2015: £2,219) the main increase arising from the repairs to the lighting equipment £1,464. All costs were met from grant funding of £4,000 received from The Romney Charity.

Investment Policy

The Trustees have considered the most appropriate policy for investing surplus funds and will continue to use the COIF Charities Investment Fund as the primary source to generate future income and capital growth for the benefit of each charity.

Reserves Policy

The trustees have agreed, within the unrestricted funds, to retain permanent reserves equating to an estimated full year's normal expenditure requirements plus a restoration reserve (£50,000) to cover unforeseen and essential renovation expenditure required to maintain the charity's property estate. This basic reserve will be subject to annual review, to reflect any major changes that may effect the charity's operations.

In accordance with the linking procedure, the total reserves of £15,955 are shown as restricted reserves on the face of the balance sheet and form no part of the unrestricted reserves of The Romney Charity.

Risk Management

The Trustees have assessed the major risks to which both charities are exposed, in particular those related to the operations and finances of the Charities, and are satisfied that systems are in place to mitigate our exposure to such risks.

Reporting Accountants

Accounting policies

Basis of accounting

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with applicable United Kingdom accounting standards, the Statement of Recommended Practice "Accounting and Reporting by Charities" issued in March 2005 (SORP 2005). Under the "linking by uniting direction" procedure, the transactions, assets and liabilities of the Millennium Green Trust are now separately identified, with the relevant comparatives shown.

Fund account

The fund account is prepared on a receipts and payments basis except where a material accrual or prepayment exists in relation to the year under review.

Taxation

The charity has been approved tax exempt status by HM Revenue & Customs.

Depreciation

Depreciation has been provided so as to write off the cost of tangible fixed assets less residual value over the estimated useful economic life as follows:

15% reducing balance

Fixed Plant & Machinery

5% straight line

Land and property are carried at valuation and any revaluation changes are stated in the notes on fixed assets with movements shown as adjustments to the accumulated fund in the year in which they occur. No depreciation is provided as the trustees are of the opinion that the normal residual value is such that the depreciation charge is considered immaterial.
