Tel: 01763 295851 Fax: 01763 247019 John Morris Turney died on 23 January 2002 and by his will dated 3 August 2001 appointed Christopher Charles Blount, Robert Edward Dimsdale, Jean Carter and Pamela Elizabeth Rosina Parker to be the executors and trustees thereof.

Jean Carter renounced her executorship. Christopher Charles Blount, Robert Edward Dimsdale and Pamela Elizabeth Rosina Parker proved the aforesaid will out of the Ipswich District Probate Registry on 17 June 2002.

Under the terms of the aforesaid will, John Morris Turney inter alia

- (1) Bequeathed the sum of £150,000 to pay the income to Stephen Shepherd for his life and upon his death to hold the capital and income upon the trust of the Turney Trust as hereinafter defined.
- (2) Bequeathed a sum of £40,000 to pay the income to Peter Turney for his life and upon his death to hold the capital and income upon the trust of the Turney Trust as hereinafter defined.
- (3) To hold the balance of his Residuary Estate:
 - To apply income and/or capital for the provision of accommodation for needy persons, in particular and in priority those individuals who have been resident in the Parishes of Reed or Therfield for at least 4 years, with preference for Reed Parishioners and any of his ex-employees.
 - Power to acquire or construct dwellings, maintain or improve.
 - Power to apply all or any part of the income and 25% of the capital for the following charities:
 - 3.1 The Royal Agricultural Benevolent Fund
 - 3.2 Letchworth Garden Hospice
 - 3.3 The Turney Village Trust

- 3.4 The Royston Branch of the St John Ambulance
- 3.5 The Royston Branch of the Red Cross.






