#### STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

The Trust is governed by its Trustees. The Trustees who served during the year are set out on page one. Further Trustees must be appointed by resolution of the existing Trustees.

#### PUBLIC BENEFIT

The Trustees have discussed the issue of public benefit and are confident that the breadth and scope of the work the Charity undertakes, as disclosed in this report, complies with Section 17 of the Charities Act 2011 and has due regard to the Charity Commission's general guidance on public benefit.

#### OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

The Trusts's objectives are to raise funds through donations and sponsored events and to distribute these funds to individuals and charities/non-profits in South Africa who are tackling the social challenges of poverty, unemployment and poor health and education.

#### ACHIEVEMENTS AND PERFORMANCE

The Trust has had another good year.

Funds donated to Kwasa College have paid for;

- teaching and administrative salaries
- bursaries for 15 students unable to afford Kwasa's 'low fee' funding model- refurbishment of the on-site Chapel/Assembly Hall
- drilling of a bore hole for an alternative water supply and the purchase of a second hand tractor/mower, and
- transport costs of a 40ft container of pre-school equipment and resources from the UK to Kwasa.

Kwasa ended the 2016 year with 116 pre-school and 66 infant/primary students.

Funds given to LifeCo UnLtd SA have funded Bridges Impact+ team to scope and define the first social venture fund to invest in social entrepreneurs in South Africa to help them achieve scale, and have also funded an intern to assist with the set-up of this fund.

In addition, the Trust has provided financial support to a student enrolled at Rosebank College in Johannesburg, and paid the fees for another to enrol at SAA's cabin crew training centre.

#### FINANCIAL REVIEW

In the year, income was £123,360 and grants and disbursements were made totalling £98,022. The Trust has no charity overheads, excepting bank and accounting fees. All funds raised benefit the recipients in South Africa.

#### PLANS FOR FUTURE PERIODS

The Trustees will continue their fundraising to enable Kwasa college to grow with new classrooms and other buildings, qualified teaching and support staff, and a flourishing bursary scheme to cover fees for those children who are unable to pay. They will also provide further support to LifeCo UnLtd and its beneficiaries
