MORECAMBE BAY CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES

The Trustees present their annual report for the year ended 31 December 2016.

1. Legal and Administrative Information

The Charity is known as Morecambe Bay Christian Fellowship, and is affiliated to Partners in Harvest. It Is a registered charity, with the registered number of 1154420.

The Charity is governed by a constitution dated 2 June 2013 and its objectives are to enhance the christian faith, the relief of sickness, poverty and distress by any means the charity can provide, to educate, promote and preserve good health and well being to mankind.

The Trustees have asked Mr Damien Sissons of Waters & Atkinson Chartered Accountants to act as the Independent Examiner under the Charities Act 2011.

Trustees are selected from within the congregation and those who have also expressed an interest in being involved in the running of the charity.

3. Activities

The Charity provides religious services, recreational and educational activities in the Morecambe and Lancaster area, and meets in the Post Office Buildings, Market Street Morecambe.

A planned programme of services, learning and education activities is provided.

The trustees have had due regard to guidance published by the charity commission on public benefit.

4. Summary of Main Achlevements

During 2016 the Fellowship became acutely aware that their current premises were inadequate to meet the needs of our elderly and less mobile members. Our building has a number of steep stairs to the main auditorium, which prevented some of our members attending church.

Negotiations were held with the management of Galloways Charitable Trust, who occupy the building next door to the current premises, with a view to using their community room for a church service on a weekly basis. As the facilities at Galloways are on the ground floor with disabled access to both the meeting room and toilet facilities, this provided an ideal opportunity for our elderly members to meet together.

This new venture has been taking place since November 2016. Our members express much joy as they meet together for fellowship and companionship. Our able bodied members provide transport for those members whose mobility is compromised.

Our plans for the future is to continue and hopefully expand our relationship with Galloways.

a) Risk Management

The Trustees regularly review the major risks associated with the charity and have developed an action plan to minimise and effectively manage those risks.

b) Reserves

It is the intention of the Trustees that taking one year with another, the expenditure incurred will match the income generated through members' contributions, tithes and donations, with the benefit of Gift Aid where applicable.

However, the Trustees attempt to maintain a working bank balance of approximately £2,000 representing approximately one month's expenditure, in order to provide a buffer in the event of interrupted income.

Financial Review

Being a small Charity, the accounts have been prepared on the basis of amounts received and paid during the year. The Statement of Assets and Liabilities (on page 4) does however show the amounts owed to, and owing by the Charity at the end of the year.

The Trustees are satisfied with the financial results for the year, and has completed the year with monies in hand.

No Capital Grants have been received in the year.
