Our Purpose and Activities

The Purpose of the Charity is:

- To Advance in life and help young people, particularly in socially and economically deprived neighbourhoods in London through:
 - 1 The provision of recreational and leisure time activities provided in the interest of social welfare, designed to improve their condition in life.
 - 2 Providing support and activities which develop their skills, capacities and capabilities to enable them to participate in society as mature and responsible individuals, in particular by the provision of film and television training and career advice.
- Main activities undertaken are:
 - 1 Games Design Training Workshop
 - 2 Film Production Training Workshop
 - 3 Group visit to Sky Careers Workshop
 - 4 Visit from Outreach from Ravensbourne University
 - 5 CV Training by BBC recruitment

Achievements and Performance

Since obtaining our charitable status we have

- Doubled our income
- Doubled our activities to 2 film training workshops and 3 games design workshops
- We have increased our engagement with the industry for apprenticeships positions
- We have increased our contacts for film talent to come and teach our young people



INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S REPORT TO THE TRUSTEES OF
THE SCREEN FILM COMMUNITY

I report on the financial statements of The Screen Film Community for the Year Ended 30th June 2016 which are set out on Pages 5 to 9.

Respective Responsibilities of Trustees and Examiner

The trustees (who are also the directors of the company for the purposes of company law) are responsible for the preparation of the accounts. The trustees consider that an audit is not required for this year under section 144(2) of the Charities Act 2011 (the 2011 Act) and is eligible for an independent examination. The charity's gross income did not exceed £250,000 and I am qualified to undertake the examination by being a qualified member of The Institute of Chartered Accountants in England & Wales.

Having satisfied myself that the charity is not subject to audit under company law and is eligible for independent examination, it is my responsibility to:

- examine the financial statements under section 145 of the 2011 Act;
- follow the procedures laid down in the general Directions given by the Charity Commission (under section 145(5)(b) of the 2011 Act; and
- state whether particular matters have come to my attention.

Basis of Independent Examiner's Report

My examination was carried out in accordance with the general Directions given by the Charity Commission. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts, and seeking explanations from you as trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit and consequently no opinion is given as to whether the accounts present a 'true and fair view' and the report is limited to those matters set out in the next statement

FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30TH JUNE 2016

1. Accounting Policies

The principal accounting policies adopted, judgements and key sources of estimation uncertainty in the preparation of the financial statements are as follows.

a) Basis of Preparation

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities published on 16th July 2014, the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective January 2015) and the Companies Act 2006. Assets and liabilities are initially recognised at historical cost or transaction value unless otherwise stated in the relevant accounting policy note(s).

b) Incoming Resources

Voluntary income, such as donations and grants are included in incoming resources when they are received.

c) Resources Expended

Resources expended are included in the Statement of Financial Activities on an accrual basis, inclusive of any VAT which cannot be recovered.

Expenditure which is directly attributable to specific activities has been included in these cost categories.

d) Fund Structure

The Funds held by the charity are either:

- Unrestricted general funds - these are funds which can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.
- Restricted Funds - these are funds that can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

e) VAT

The charity is not registered for VAT and accordingly expenditure includes VAT where appropriate.
