Annual Accounts

The Trustees agreed that the Society should change to the Receipts and Payments method of accounting, so the attached Accounts use this format for the first time.

The Society's banking arrangements are unchanged, and healthy balances are maintained in both accounts.

Patronage Scheme

The contribution made by Friends and Patrons to the Society's ability to fund concerts continues to be significant. Some subscribers to the Friends Scheme have been lost but we have acquired some new Friends. In particularly, we have eleven new patron/sponsors, all local businesses, who subscribed between £100 and £500 for the year 2016. In return they received complimentary tickets to major concerts and their businesses were advertised in the concert programmes and on the Society's website.

Social Fund

The Social Fund is financed by the sale of cakes and raffle tickets each week. It continues to provide a significant contribution to the Society's funds and the Committee is grateful to the members for their regular support.

Concerts

It has been an eventful year. On 7th November the Society joined with the Hull Choral Union for a performance of Verdi's Requiem in the Hull City Hall. Our Christmas Concert in St Nicholas Church, Lincoln, raised £310 for the "Hope for Tomorrow" Mobile Chemotherapy Unit Project.

The Society's performance of Sir Karl Jenkins' "Armed Man" last year resulted in an invitation to join with members of various international choirs in a performance of this work in the Carnegie Hall, New York. About a quarter of our singers went on this trip of a lifetime, entirely at their own expense, but under the auspices of the Society. It involved a considerable amount of work, which our Chairman undertook, and was much appreciated by those who went.

On 2nd April the Society celebrated the Queen's 90th Birthday with a performance of Vivaldi's "Gloria" and Handel's "Coronation Anthems" in Lincoln Cathedral.

The Society's year finished on 17th June with a programme entitled "William Shakespeare – Musical Muse" in the newly refurbished "St Katherine's Cathedral Church" in Lincoln.

Society's Trustees and Officers

No member of the Society receives any form of remuneration for the deliverance of their duties.

Reserves and Investments

The Trustees are pleased that the Society is in surplus, but continue to exercise diligence in applying budgetary control. No assistance has been received from any form of Grant Aid, and the Society has not investments.

INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S REPORT ON THE ACCOUNTS

Report to the trustees/members of the Lincoln Choral Society on the accounts for the year ended 31st July 2016.

Respective responsibility of trustees and examiner

The Charity's Trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts. The Charity's Trustees consider that an audit is not required for this year (under section 43(2) of the Charities Act 1993 (the Act) and that an independent examination is needed.
