Annual Report of the Trustees of the New London Music Society September 2016

The New London Music Society (NLMS) was formed in 1981 by the conductor Terence Lovett. The object of the Society was to promote, improve, develop and maintain public education and appreciation of the art and science of music in all its aspects by the promotion and organisation of annual music summer schools. Each year the NLMS Summer School welcomes over a hundred enthusiastic adult amateur musicians for a week of enjoyable music making, with expert tuition from experienced music tutors. For 2016, in the light of positive feedback from the participants at its initial offering, the Society ran a third chamber music weekend.

Trustees

- 1. There were six Trustees of the Society in 2015-16: Philip Meaden (Chair), Steve Walker (Secretary), Lorraine Collins, Ron Kelley, Euan McCandless and Jacob Ashworth. From its inception, the Society was a membership association, the Trustees of which were elected by resolutions of the members at Annual General Meetings. The Society remains a membership association.
- 2. Trustees elected for the period 2016-17 are: Philip Meaden (Chair), Steve Walker (Secretary), Lorraine Collins, Allan Wright, Charles Westendarp, Ron Kelley, Euan McCandless and Jacob Ashworth.
- 3. The Society's correspondent is Mr. Steve Walker, Secretary of the NLMS.

Finance

- 1. The financial statement for the year ending 30th September 2015 shows a modest profit; income exceeded expenditure for the year by £1,111.
- 2. The Society's reserves stand at a total of £53,378 held in various accounts. Reserves are held primarily in order for the Trustees to book accommodation in advance for the following year's summer school.
- 3. The Trustees have reviewed the major risks to which the Society is exposed and systems are in place to mitigate them.

Courses

In 2016 the New London Music Society organized two major events: the third offering of a string chamber music weekend; and another offering in the successful series of music summer schools.

Chamber Music Weekend

- 1. The chamber music weekend consisted this time of pre-formed groups only, coached, as before, by an established professional quartet.
- 2. The feedback from the participants was positive and enables the Society to plan a further, similar, offering in 2017.

Music Summer School

1. The summer school consisted of five courses: two orchestras, (the Symphony Orchestra for those of Grade 8 standard, and the Sinfonietta for those of Grades 5-7), the String Ensemble, the Wind Group and the Choir – "Choral Singing for Pleasure".

- Specialist tutors coached sectional rehearsals focused on concert repertoire for both
 orchestras and the Choir. The String and Wind Ensembles were coached by tutors who
 have specialized in teaching adults. Tutors also led the string sections of both orchestras,
 and the Choir sections. String, wind and brass ensembles were also timetabled, again
 coached by relevant tutors.
- 3. The 2016 Summer School proved to be a happy and successful occasion with excellent feedback from the members.
