#### **REPORT OF THE DIRECTORS**

As we look back over the last year of our life as a congregation at Emmanuel Evangelical Church, we have a great deal to thank God for.

We have continued to hold weekly services of worship, open to all members of the public. We've continued to see new people joining the congregation, though sadly a couple of longstanding families and some other members have moved away. Yet even the loss of some very dear friends has brought unexpected blessings, as other people have stepped up to take on new responsibilities. Our services have been followed by opportunities for open discussion, providing a context for people to raise questions and make comments about matters of particular interest.

In addition to our regular Sunday services, we continue to hold a number of conferences each year featuring a range of speakers, and also an annual Summer School for teenagers. Autumn 2016 saw the highly successful launch of a new conference for families and young people organised with significant input from the young people themselves. Our Minister continues to teach a course in Christian theology to a number of people from London and beyond, and enrolment this year is at the highest level ever.

We have made personal contact with hundreds of people in the local community. The reaction has been very positive. Dozens of people have accepted our invitation to discuss matters of personal and religious interest with our Minister and other members of the congregation.

We run free English Classes every week for people whose first language is not English, with the aim of helping international residents in our community to communicate more confidently, make new friends, and to seek support in personal and practical matters if required.

Our website has provided an educational and religious resource for people beyond our local geographical area. All of our sermons and many other audio and written resources are made available free online.

#### NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE PERIOD ENDED 31 OCTOBER 2016

#### 1 Accounting Policies

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Statement of Recommended Practise, Accounting and Reporting by Charities (SORP 2005), applicable accounting standards and the Companies Act 1985. The principal accounting policies adopted in preparation of the financial statements are as follows:

### RECOGNITION OF INCOMING RESOURCES

These are included in the Statement of Financial Activities (SoFA) when:

- . the charity becomes entitled to the resources;
- · the trustees are virtually certain they will receive the resources; and

. the monetary value can be measured with sufficient reliably.

#### GRANTS AND DONATIONS

Grants and donations are only included in the SoFA when the charity has unconditional entitlement to the resources.

### TAX RECLAIMS ON DONATIONS AND GIFTS

Incoming resources from tax reclaims are included in the SoFA at the same time as the gift to which they relate.

#### VOLUNTEER HELP

The value of any voluntary help received is not included in the accounts but is described in the trustees' annual report.

#### LIABILITY RECOGNITION

Liabilities are recognised as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to pay out resources.

#### FUND ACCOUNTING

Funds held by the Company are either:

- Unrestricted general funds these can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the directors
- Restricted funds restrictions arise when specified by donors or the advertised purpose of an appeal, and such funds can only be used for the particular restricted purpose within the objectives of the charity.

During the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> October 2016 the charity had unrestricted general funds, and restricted funds for the purpose of Christian education. All restricted funds were disbursed by year end.

### 2 Capital Commitments and Contingent Liabilities

At 31st October 2016 there were no capital commitments or contingent liabilities.
