**Trustees** 

The trustees, all of whom have served for the whole of 2016/17 are Tom White (chairman), Hugh Nightingale (secretary), Graham Hukins, Neil Instrall and Richard Maxwell.

#### Governance

The constitution of The Terrier Trust CIO (TTT-CIO) was approved by the Charity Commission on 26 February 2016. The charity is a charitable incorporated organisation (CIO) having an 'Association' Model Constitution and minimum of three and a maximum of five trustees.

At every annual general meeting of the members of the CIO, one-third of the charity trustees shall retire from office and are eligible for re-election. All trustees give their time voluntarily and receive no remuneration or other benefits.

The TTT-CIO was created to replace the unincorporated charity The Terrier Trust (Registered Charity No 1050480). The transition of TTT to TTT-CIO has begun and all members of TTT are also members of TTT-CIO. All the assets and liabilities of TTT will be transferred into the TTT-CIO in an orderly fashion, after which TTT will be closed. The delay in reaching agreement with the Kent & East Sussex Railway (K&ESR) on the new locomotive hire agreements has prevented the completion of the transition process and identification of a final closure date for TTT.

### **Objectives and Activities**

To advance the education of the public about the engineering achievement and legacy of steam railway engines, in particular but not exclusively by the acquisition, preservation, restoration and maintenance of locomotives of the Terrier Class, designed by William Stroudley of the former London Brighton and South Coast Railway, for public display and operation.

During 2016/17, TTT's Terrier locomotives 32670 *Bodiam* (75% owned by TTT and the remaining 25% owned by the K&ESR) and 32678 *Knowle* (100% owned by TTT) remain the property of TTT and a report of their activities during the period under review is given in TTT's annual report.

Progress on the renegotiation of the hire agreements for both locomotives, which began in 2009, is given in TTT's annual report.

#### **Achievements and Performance**

#### **Financial Review**

As at 31 January 2017, the balance on TTT-CIO's bank accounts was £975, none of which is held in a restricted fund. TTT-CIO will adopt TTT's existing financial policies once the locomotives and all the financial assets have been transferred across. During 2016/17, £1,000 was transferred from TTT in the new TTT-CIO bank account and £975 remains after the payment of the membership subscription for the Heritage Railway Association. All transition administration expenditure is borne by TTT.
