Advancing in life and helping young people by developing their skills, capacities and capabilities to enable them to participate in society as independent mature and responsible individuals;  2. Advancing education;  3. Providing recreational and leisure time activity in the interests of social welfare for people living in the area of benefit who have need by reason of their youth, age, infirmity or disability, poverty or social and economic circumstances with a view to improving the conditions of life for such persons.

Para 1.17 and 1.19	The Connections Bus Project is based in Histon near Cambridge and runs mobile youth facilities which operate from a converted double decker bus and also supports building based facilities in some communities.  The charity's vision is to enable young people to fulfil their potential through the provision of free recreational, educational and personal development opportunities. We work in communities which do not have their own youth clubs by providing a place where young people can meet and relax in an informal setting and experience a range of positive and challenging activities.  Recreational opportunities include, personal computers with high speed internet access, games consoles, outdoor sports, crafts, puzzles, games, music videos and a TV. Social opportunities include a safe place to meet and specially designed areas to sit and chat with friends and youth workers. Educational opportunities include youth workers to support young people with information and advice on subjects such as drugs, sexual health, education and employment.

		The facilities are open to any young person aged between 11 and 19 years. On average they see around 20 young people each session, both male and female.
