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REPORT TO THE PARISH COUNCIL FINANCIAL YEAR ENDING 31ST MARCH 2017

During the year the Charity has sold a small piece of land to a tenant and, on financial consultant advice, withdrawn investment in a charity fund offering poor returns. The cash raised has been invested in another Charity Commission approved fund to generate substantially increased annual returns. English Woodland Grant Scheme funds support ongoing maintenance and replacement planting in the Charity's wooded land at Horsford. This, combined with land rents and a small amount of timber sales has increased available funds, enabling the Trustees to continue the policy of maintaining a satisfactory level of payments to needy parishioners.

It was possible to increase the level of individual payments for the Spring 2017 allocations by £5 per person over the Autumn 2016 grant, with totals as follows:

Autumn 2016 allocation: 42 recipients £4,555

Spring 2017 allocation: 42 recipients $\underline{£4,720}$

TOTAL £9,275

That total is a 4.7% increase on the previous year.

The Trustees have applied the advice of Norfolk Community Council on the application and allocation process to ensure that, as far as possible, applicants are in real need.

Currently the Trustees are Mr. Paul Elsegood (Chairman), Rev. Keith Rengert, Dr. Jamie Dalrymple, Mrs. Hazel Howes and Mrs. Wendy Nash.
