ENRYCH OXFORDSHIRE/CHAIRMAN'S REPORT 2016/17

The year has been a difficult one for the charity, having lost the OCC grant of over £66,000 as a result of county-wide cuts. Two members of staff were made redundant as a consequence and one left. Two Coordinators remained, one to serve the north of the county and one the south, but the impact on our service to disabled adults has been considerable. In due course, both of these Coordinators also left for various reasons but, fortunately, one of our most experienced members of staff returned to the charity and has been making great progress in restoring a skeleton service.

We have also appointed a part-time Fundraiser, again an experienced former member of staff, who is having considerable success in raising funds. We hope this will enable us to appoint a second Coordinator in due course.

The going is hard for many charities at present and Enrych Oxfordshire is no exception. However, we are beginning to rebuild the help and support we offer to disabled adults in the county and we are optimistic and determined that we can extend the leisure and learning opportunities across the county, to help reduce social isolation and raise self esteem for our members.'
