For the year ending 31 March 2017, the company was entitled to exemption from audit under section 477 of the Companies Act 2006 relating to small companies.

Principal Activities

The principal activity of the Association is to promote the well-being of the community and residents in West Heath for which purposes as may, by law, be deemed charitable. To associate local authorities, voluntary organisations and residents in common effort to advance education, to further health, to provide recreation and to foster a community spirit.

Financial Report for the Year to 31st March 2017.

The Association suffered a significant loss across all 3 areas, i.e. Playgroup, Day Centre and Hampstead House. Due to early implementation of reduced costs and improved income the situation was controlled and the Association was left with sufficient reserves at year end.

As a result of this financial strategy in mid-2016-17 the finances of the Association now are in a healthier state, despite the overall poor year they faced in 2016/17. The Playgroup has now closed and the staff made redundant.

The results of its operations during the year are reflected in the financial statements.

Future Developments

The continued implementation by the Trustees and Directors of the financial strategy and business plan agreed in 2016.
