### Wye Almshouse Charity

### Report of the Trustees for Year Ending 31<sup>st</sup> March 2017

#### Summary of Activities

Apart from a two month period between one resident moving out and a new resident being appointed all the Almshouses have been fully occupied throughout the year. The resident's contributions amounted to £21,041. The Trustees have reviewed the Resident's Contributions as in previous years and as of 1<sup>st</sup> April 2017 the contribution will increase to £56.00 per week. The operating costs were £31,413 making the comparative operating cost higher than previous years due to monies spent on secondary glazing & new boilers to some of the properties and some external decorating. Loan repayments amounted to £5,416, purchase of investments to £1,600. Miscellaneous payments amounted to £160 resulting in a deficit of £6,165 between income and expenditure. The closing bank balance stands at £22,236.

#### Risk Management

The Trustees have examined the major strategic, business and operational risks which the Charity faces and confirm that systems have been established to enable the Charity to lessen or mitigate those risks.

#### Appointment of Trustees

No more than seven members make up the Register of Trustees. Three Trustees are appointed by the Parish Council, three are nominated by the other Trustees and the seventh is always the Vicar of Wye or his representative. Normally when a Trustee retires a new one is appointed as soon as possible however there may be a gap of a few months before this is can be achieved.
