Report of the Trustees

The trustees presents its annual report and the unaudited financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2017.

Review of the current year

The trustees are delighted to report that the church stand to be successful spiritually by ministering to many people in different location. Being around these children for two weeks was an inspiration for them. We hope that in the coming years we will able to do more and expand our coast in meeting needs of more children.

Future Plans

In the coming year, we are planning to visit Malawi; one of the poorest countries in the world. The church is planning to supply clothing, school materials and feeding programme for four orphanage homes. The church is also planning to train children in our local community who have interest in various musical instruments such as keyboard, guitar, trumpet, drum sets etc. Besides, we are also planning, 'Christmas feed the poor' in our local community next year December. We are intending to support the homeless and vulnerable people during Christmas season to put smile on their faces. The church is also planning to train more leaders in the coming year to enhance the effectiveness of our organisation.
