<u>Trustees' Report</u> for the Year Ended 31 March 2017

The trustees present their report and the accounts for the year ended 31 March 2017.

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Significant activities

The principal activity of the charity during the year was to provide care for sick, unwanted and neglected cats and kittens. The cats and kittens are rescued and re-homed to new loving homes where possible. No cat is put to sleep unless it is suffering and has no hope of recovery.

Public benefit

When considering the aims of the charity the trustees have had regard to the guidance issued by the Charity Commission on public benefit.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Reserves policy

It is the aim of the trustees to maintain funds at a level which equates to approximately one years expenditure. This provides sufficient funds to cover management, administration and support costs and to respond to emergency needs, which may arise from time to time.

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

Governing document

Cat Action Trust - North and West Wiltshire was registered as a charity on 21 August 1995 (registered under charity number 1048779). The Trust is governed by a constitution, which was adopted on 9 August 1995. The Association was established to provide care of sick or neglected animals and to prevent cruelty to animals in the North and West Wiltshire area.

Recruitment and appointment of new trustees

The Board of Trustees seeks to ensure that the needs of the Trust are appropriately served through the diversity of the trustee body. The more traditional business skills are well represented on the Board of Trustees. In the event of particular skills being lost due to retirements, individuals are approached to offer themselves for election to the Board of Trustees.

Risk management

The trustees have undertaken a detailed consideration of the financial and other risks to which the charity may be exposed and they have agreed that these are adequately mitigated by the nature of the charity's activities and the specific circumstances in which it operates. Internal control risks are minimised by the implementation of procedures for authorisation of all transactions and projects. Procedures are in place to ensure compliance with health and safety of staff, volunteers and associates. These procedures are periodically reviewed to ensure that they continue to meet the requirements of the charity in satisfying the statutory and moral obligations imposed by its activities.
