Marylebone Bangladesh Society was established in 1979 and was registered as a charity at the Charity Commission on the 13 February 1991.

Principal activities

The charity exists to improve the quality of life for Bengali community in London Borough of Westminster in the areas of housing, employment, education, social and environmental conditions, providing facilities for recreation and leisure and advancement of education by organising cultural, educational and social activities of non-political nature.

Results

The net incoming resources for the year amounted to £3,147(2016 \pm 10,479).

1 Accounting Policies

1.1 Basis of Preparation

- 1.4 The charity is not registered for VAT and accordingly expenditure is shown gross of irrecoverable VAT.
- 1.5 Tangible Fixed Assets & Depreciation

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost less depreciation. Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost less estimated residual value of each asset over its expected useful life, as follows:
