These relief causes include Hurricane Katrina, British Summer Floods, Whitechapel mission, White Ribbon's Alliance, Japan Red Cross (Earthquake and Tsunami). Udayan Care, Typhoon Haiyan and Disasters Emergency Committee – Ebola.
