The trustees submit their report and the unaudited financial statements for Torquay United Community Sports Trust Ltd for the year to 30 June 2017.

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Companies Act and the Statement of Recommended Practice on accounting and reporting for charities (revised 2005).

Structure, Governance and Management

The charity (number 1125138) is a company limited by guarantee (Number 06618877) incorporated 12 June 2008 and governed by its memorandum and articles of association. The charity is run by a board of trustees, who are also directors for the purposes of the Companies Act and who are named at the front of this report.

The Trustees meet at least once a quarter throughout the year to evaluate, to review activities, financial performance and for forward planning. Day to day running of the Trust is handled by the Management Team, who liase frequently (and are line-managed) by individual Trustees and report at Trustee Meetings.

Objectives and Activities

The Charity's objectives are for the benefit of the public generally and in particular the inhabitants of Devon and its surrounding areas:-

To promote community participation in healthy recreation by providing facilities for the playing of association football and other sports capable of improving health.

To provide and assist in providing sport, recreation or other leisure time occupation of such persons who have need for such facilities by reason of their youth, age infirmity or disablement, poverty or social and economic circumstances or for the public at large in the interest of social welfare and with the object of improving their conditions of life and to advance the education of children and young people.

Torquay United Community Sports Trust Ltd provides a wide range of activities throughout South Devon helping people to achieve a healthy, active lifestyle. We aim to inspire people to reach their full potential using fun and friendly activities.

Mission Statement

Our main areas of business are school lessons/session and evening football clubs. Working in and around South Devon, we try and visit as many schools as we can from the 128 based in the South Devon area. From July 2016 to June 2017 we averaged 1000 children per week. Throughout the year this will total up to 50,000. We currently run 13 football clubs on a weekly basis for children aged 3 - 14 years every night of the week. From July 2016 to June 2017 we averaged 237 children per week resulting in a yearly average of 10,804.

In all our football activities we encourage high levels of fair play, sportsmanship and team play. We express the importance of being fit and healthy in all areas of life. Together with structured football sessions and a professional positive approach, the achievements we get from the children we reach are brilliant.

Reserves -

At 30 June 2017 the charity had reserves of £65,597 £11,954 of which is restricted. The trustees intend to maintain sufficient reserves to meet the ongoing expenditure of the charity and the amount held at 30 June 2017 was believed to be sufficient.

In setting our objectives and planning our activities the trustees have given consideration to the Charity Commission's guidance on public benefit.

Method of recruitment and appointment of trustees

Trustees are recruited from within the local community to reflect the different aspects of sports, finance and general business. Currently we have six trustees but are actively seeking to increase this to seven. Appointments are made at a trustees' meeting using normal voting procedures.

1. Accounting Policies Basis of preparation

Fund Accounting Policy

Unrestricted income funds are general funds that are available for use at the trustees' discretion in furtherance of the objectives of the charity

Restricted funds are those donated for use in a particular area or for specific purposes the use of which is restricted to that are or purpose

Further details of each fund are disclosed in note 17

Incoming resources

Voluntary income including donations and grants that provide core funding or are of a general nature is recognised where there is entitlement certainty of receipt and the amount can be measured with sufficient reliability.

Investment income is recognised on a receivable basis.

Resources expended

Liabilities are recognised as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to the expenditure. All expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under heading that aggregate all costs related to the category.

Costs of generating funds comprise the costs associated with attracting voluntary income and the costs of trading for fundraising purposes.

Governance Costs

Governance costs include costs of the preparation and examination of the statutory accounts the costs of trustee meetings and the cost of any legal advice to trustees on governance or constitutional matters.

Fixed Assets

Individual fixed assets costing £0 or more are initially recorded at cost.

Depreciation

Depreciation is provided on tangible fixed assets so as to write off the cost or valuation, less any estimated residual value over their expected useful economic life as follows:
