Actual Income £118120.00 – 39k above budget

Actual Costs £117818.00 - 13.5 above budget

Overall we were £26258 in favour as opposed to overall budgeted estimates [both income and costs].

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Noticeable gains in income

Hall/Meeting room rent - £2k over budget

Donations - £1k over budget

Gift Aid reclaimed was £18.1k over year which was £11.6k over budget

Events raised 7.8k

Expenditure

Parish Share was underpaid by £2.8k

We spent almost 4k less than was budgeted as St.John's maintenance costs.

Conclusion

Having the additional Gift Aid which included one amount from 2016 gave us a boost and this together with increased income from events assisted us.

The decrease in costs was primarily because we had a 'year of consolidation' without any major need for repairs or extraordinary costs.

It is far too early to assess whether there has been any benefit from the change of utility supplier as implemented by the finance panel – we shall be able to assess if this has made any significant difference at the end of next year.

It was an aspiration for us to cover our day to day costs by the 'ordinary' income of the church. This has been achieved during 2017 and it I hoped that we can continue to cover such running costs in a similar way in to the future.

ST JOHN THE BAPTIST WITH ST EDMUND, FELIXSTOWE INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S REPORT TO THE TRUSTEES (MEMBERS OF THE PAROCHIAL CHURCH COUNCIL)

This report on the financial statements of the PCC for the year ended 2017 is in respect of an examination carried out in accordance with the Church Accounting Regulations 2006 ('the regulations') and the Charities Act 2011 ('the Act').
