Summary of the objects of the charity set out in its governing document

The objects of the CIO are to end the suffering of dogs and other animals throughout Taiwan by all positive means, including and not limited to physically rescuing animals in danger or in need of urgent medical attention, providing lifelong, species-appropriate, quality care to animals unlikely to find a good home elsewhere, responsibly rehoming animals from our care as well as suitable free-roaming animals and those in local shelters, improving the wellbeing of all animals in the surrounding area through a community outreach and CNR program, providing discounted veterinary care to those otherwise unable to afford treatment for their animals, and raising the level of animal welfare through education.

Summary of the main activities undertaken for the public benefit in relation to these objects (include within this section the statutory declaration that trustees have had regard to the guidance issued by the Charity Commission on public benefit) People for Animal Care and Kindness set up and ran one of Taiwan's largest and best animal-rescue sanctuaries. During the year ending on 30/4/16, the sanctuary rescued or brought in 180 animals in dire need of veterinary treatment or other assistance. Ten of the twelve rescued wildlife were released back into the wild, 24 of the dogs and 3 of the cats were responsibly rehomed, and most of the remainder have been provided and guaranteed lifelong quality care. When planning activities, the trustees kept in mind the Charity Commision's guidelines on public benefit.
