Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the year

Fundralsing for the year reached £12,390 and was achieved through organised events including a golf day, a charity ball and raffles.

The Foundation made charitable donations totalling £12,350 during the year.

These donations included the giving of food hampers to 24 families that otherwise would have struggled financially at Christmas time. A number of small individual donations were also given to help with the buying of Christmas presents.

Ormiston Academy Trust were given funding towards a sports day event and Potential Plus benefitted from funding towards 8 Big Family Days and Workshops.

The Ridge Academy received help for the funding of a member of for the provision of academic and therapeutic days for their children.
