

Church Attendance

Following the revision of the Church electoral roll for the 2017 APCM there were 98 parishioners on the roll.

The average weekly adult attendance counted during October 2017 was 73. The number in attendance on Easter Day 2017 was 97, on Christmas Eve & Day was 158.

There were 7 baptisms, 2 weddings and there were 21 Bingham parish funerals.
