TRUSTEES' ANNUAL REPORT

The Trustees of Ezer Bekovoid Limited ("the Charity") present their Annual Report along with the Accounts of the Charity ("the Accounts") for the 7 Months from 1 April 2016 to 31 October 2016. The Accounts have been prepared in accordance with the Accounting Policies set out on Page 9 and comply with the Declaration of Trust and applicable law.

• OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

The Trustees stand possessed of the Trust Fund which they hold for the Charity, to further the objects of the Charity, which are primarily:

The Charity's objects ("Objects") are specifically restricted to the following

- (i) The advancement of the Orthodox Jewish Faith
- (ii) The advancement of education
- (iii) The relief of poverty, and
- (iv) Such other objects as are for the benefit of the public and are charitable according to the laws of England and Wales

At present, the Charity provides grants and loans to other similar organisations, as well as to other organisations and individuals, both in the United Kingdom and abroad, recognized as Charitable in English Law.

Grant Making Policy

All applications to the Charity for grants are considered carefully by the Trustees at regular meetings. On most occasions, if the Trustees feel that the application meets their approval in principle, they will meet applicants face to face and discuss with them details of the application. The Trustees usually then have a further meeting before making a decision as to whether assistance should be granted, and if so, to what level. All grants must be approved by the unanimous agreement of the Trustees.

Charities and Public Benefit

The Trustees have considered the Charity Commission's general guidance on public benefit and are satisfied that the Charity complies with that guidance.

• ACHIEVEMENTS AND PERFORMANCE

Further monies were raised for the Keser Malchus Girls School and Bachatzros Kodshecho Boys School.

The Charity has also donated grants and food to individuals in Israel who have found themselves in particular financial hardship.

Medical assistance has also been provided to assist individuals requiring specialised medical help abroad.

A convention was organised during the year, various lectures were given, in which the charitable activities were presented to the wider community.

During the 7 month accounting period ended 31 October 2016 donations of £992k (31 March 2016: £823k) were raised and the Trustees view this as a major achievement and hereby acknowledge all those who made donations to the Charity.

• FINANCIAL REVIEW

Summary of Results for the 7 month Accounting Period

The Charity raised voluntary income of £991,816 (Year ended 31 March 2016: £823,007) and made charitable grants of £786,561 (Year ended 31 March 2016: £807,721) during the 7 month accounting period. Total resources expended amounted to £861,961 (Year ended 31 March 2016: £829,816), leaving net resources carried forward of £252,434 (2016: £122,579).

The Trustees are satisfied with the results for the 7 month Accounting Period.

Reserves Policy

The Trustees do not seek to maintain significant levels of reserves, other than to ensure that they can continue the activities of the Charity. The Charity has very low operating overheads and as such does not need to keep large sums in reserve. Minimal amounts will however be retained annually to cover incidental expenses.

Investments Policy

The Charity holds a current account. The policy of the Charity is to continue holding this account for its ongoing charitable project expenditure.
