
School of Sip-Puff Sailing

The Miss Isle School of Sip-Puff Sailing was set up to offer severely disabled young people the opportunity to sail a boat orally.

In order to deliver the Trust's objective, a number of policies had to be put in place before the first person could benefit from the Trust. As a result, during the first twelve months the Trustees finalised the Public Liability offer, signed off the Standard Operating Procedures, secured a permanent base at Cowes Yacht Haven, acquired a sponsor to rebuild the support boat and to seek further qualified sailing instructors.

The Trustees managed to still have time to fund raise through the year and are now well placed to support those wishing to set sail. The first person to benefit from the Trust will be attending the School during the Autumn and will feature as part of next year's report.
