Structure, Governance and Management

Objectives and Activities

The Charity's aims are for the public benefit in accordance with Christian principles: the advancement of education for children and young people in Zambia and such other parts of the world as the charity trustees may from time to time decide; and the relief of those in need by reason of financial hardship, unemployment, sickness or other social or economic disadvantage.

Achievements & Performance

- During the period under review, ZEMS was involved with providing funds to support the following: School fees for boys connected with Old MacDonald's Farm.
- Supporting the education of over 150 children and assisting in the building of a new school block at Taonga school
- Supporting the care of orphans at Ikelenge Orphan Village
