Annual Report 2018

During 2017, Christ's Church Harwood conducted 27 Baptisms and 4 Weddings. We conducted 24 funerals (14 of which took place in Church).

Services were held for all the major Christian festivals, going through the year from Ash Wednesday and Mothering Sunday, and ending 2017 with our Christmas celebrations. Throughout the year we held regular Sunday Services at 8.30 and 10.30. In the main our Services were well attended and we pray that our congregations continue to grow in 2018. Our Church also met regularly for Parish Prayers.

Our Children's and youth groups met regularly during 2017 with our Fish and Church Collective groups catering for children of all ages. In addition, Christ's Church also organised King's Club, a Christian 1 week holiday club for children. Also we ran Scouts, Rainbows, Brownies, Beavers, Guides and Cubs groups. As a Church we continue to work closely with St Catherine's Academy, particularly the Awesome after school club.

During the year the following groups met on a weekly basis, house groups (for Prayer and fellowship), the men's group, Mother's union and the mother and toddlers group.

In addition our Pastoral and Bereavement teams met regularly with each other, and ministered to our local community.

In 2017 we ran an Alpha course. We also joined with the other Churches in Harwood for an Ecumenical Lent course and a Palm Sunday procession and walk of witness. 2017 was a busy year for events with events such as the summer fair and the Dickensian Christmas fair, amongst many other things!

2017 was a busy year as we launched our Mission Action Planning process with a Vision day at St. Catherine's Academy, making sure that we reach out into our local community, which is an essential part of our role as a church: within the local community and working for the local community.
