### Basis of independent examiner's statement

My examination was carried out in accordance with general Directions given by the Charity Commission. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts, and seeking explanations from the trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit, and consequently no opinion is given as to whether the accounts present a 'true and fair' view and the report is limited to those matters set out in the statement below.

## Independent examiner's statement-

#### Matter of concern identified

In connection with my examination, I have identified matters of concern that gives me reasonable cause to believe that:

- accounting records were not kept in accordance with section 130 of the Charities Act; and
- the accounts do not accord with those records.

The receipts and payments accounts prepared show a loss of takings. This is the difference from takings recorded less expenses recorded and monies banked.
