Joint Chad project: We carried out a project with Chad in conjunction with the International Medical Corps (IMC). The aim of the project was to equip the mobile units operated by IMC in Bagasola, Chad. The project was started in early 2016 and concluded in February 2017 with the sum of £2500 donated to IMC to purchase the equipment needed based on a needs assessment we carried out with them.
