### **2. Chairman's Report**

Mrs. Truss welcomed everyone and said how nice it was to see a good crowd. She was enjoying her first year as Chairman and fund raising was still going well. Jay was thanked for doing the refreshments and Jayne and Wayne for taking away left over jumble. Grateful thanks to her hard working Committee, Officers and Helpers and to everyone who, whatever the weather, turn up at our events, even in the bitterly cold winter and spring this year.

It was the first time ever we had to cancel the Mad March Fayre due to icy conditions and a power cut.

Over £7,000 was donated to the St. Richard's Hospital Fernhurst Unit for 6 Comfy Armchairs, 6 Tables and 2 TVs, for those receiving cancer treatment. Last month we also gave them £5,832 for 4 Sofas and £1,175 for Dr. Karim's Dermatoscope for early diagnosis of skin cancers.
