Key HoL supporters, Elizabeth Pearn and Sandra Cooper, have brought back encouraging reports of life at the Namadhi orphanage following their 2 week visit.



Their most humbling time was washing clothes with the 3 House Mums, Juliana, Marie & Annette.

They also saw the new kitchen, which was previously funded by stalwart supporters from the Portsmouth area who raised the money via a gruelling Night Ride through London.



The new kitchen caters for 600 primary children. New staff toilets are now in use, as well as a new generator for lighting. A second borehole has recently been established, which provides water for both drinking and washing.
