Achievements and performance

Achievements

During the year the trustees made 12 grants (2016: 12) to beneficiaries totalling £15,700 (2016: £15,195). The market value of the trust's investments increased by £103,752 to £1,253,089.

Trustees' Annual Report for the year ended 31 December 2017 (cont'd)

Financial Review

The total value of the fund increased by £128,777 which was mainly due to the increased value of the Trust's investments. The total reserves are £1,361,022 of which £154,086 are unrestricted and £1,206,936 are permanent endowment.

Reserves

The current level of unrestricted reserves (£154,086 at 31 December 2017) is considered by the trustees to be sufficient to allow them to make grants under the charity's primary object, that is for the relief of need, and also under its secondary object, that is in order to further the religious and other charitable work of the Church of England in the area of benefit.

The Trustees have determined that should unrestricted reserves reduce to £50,000 it will be necessary for them to reconsider this decision and to prioritise grants which are focussed on the relief of need. In selecting the £50,000 floor, the Trustees are mindful of the need to have in reserve sufficient funds available to meet the needs of occasional cases that require a larger than average grant.

Public Benefit

The Trustees are aware of the Charity Commission's guidance on public benefit and have had regard to it in their administration of the trust. The Trustees believe that the objectives of the trust meet the public benefit requirements and that the activities for the year are in accordance with the objectives.

1. Basis of preparation

1.1 Basis of accounting
