2. Chair of the Trustees Report

Baby Basics Northampton has had a really successful year reaching over 600 baskets and ensuring provision across the county.

The Operational Team have worked tirelessly to ensure a high standard and are an inspiration to the Trustees. As the service provision has grown the team are putting in place plans to start using volunteers in the day to day working of the charity, this has the benefit of supporting the increased demand whilst also sharing the vision of Baby Basics. The team have also worked to develop positive partnerships with Tescos and Amazon to raise money and spread the word of Baby Basics Northampton.

The Operational Team structure has developed to support the team in providing for the growing demand. One of the big supportive factors has been the location of the team within the Kairos Centre with space to store goods and also prepare baskets, enabling the service to move out of the teams homes into a central location. In addition, the team now have job descriptions / work plans to support their role and provide clarity for their development in the team.

The Trustees have now settled into their role in the charity and ensure support to the operational team in their daily working, we aim to give support to the team whilst also ensuring objective strategic decision making in the development of the charity, this is all possible through the connection with the operational team. This has proved a solid relationship to support growth in the coming years.

The Trustees would like to thank all the staff in the team as well as the generous giving from the community, other agencies as well as the support and prayers from Grange Park Church. We are looking forward to another exciting year providing not just baskets of essentials but hope for new mothers in need.

3. Financial Report

Baby Basics Accounts for 12 months (from 1 September 2015 to 30 September 2016)

Baby Basics stated the financial year with cash of £5,295. Total donations received were £25,139, resulting in cash increasing to £13,985 on 30 September 2016. By far the largest donation was £20,000 from Peterborough Diocese received on 29 February 2016. (The first instalment of a total grant award of £60,000).

During the year the charity spent a total of £13,984. This can be broken down into £9,258 on wages, £3,599 on supplies for starter kits and £3,592 spent on administration expenses. Following receipt of the £20,000 Diocese grant it was agreed by the trustees to increase salary costs to £17,600 per year, these additional salaries commenced on 1 April 2016. The Trustees also committed to travel expense costs of approximately £2,600 per annum.

Accounts for 8 months (from 1 September 2016 to 30 April 2017)

The first 8 months of the current financial year have seen cash increase from £13,984 to £22,474. Income received so far totals £28,386. Made up of grants totalling £25,625 and donations of £2,762. This includes the second £20,000 instalment of the Peterborough Diocese Grant received in 3 February 2017.

During the first 8 months of the year a total of £19,897 has been spent. This can be broken down into £11,733 on wages, £2,351 spent on supplies for starter kits and £5,813 spent on admin expenses. Monthly expenditure is roughly £2,500, therefore Baby Basics currently has sufficient funds to continue for the next 9 months.

4. Operations Review

Operations Overview:

Baby Basics Northampton has had a busy 2016-2017. We have recently celebrated our 4th Birthday in January 2017 and have sent out over 600 starter packs.

Baby Basics Northampton has experienced an increase use of our service when we returned from our summer break in September 2016. The Operations Team have put in to place changes to the referral process to accommodate the increased volume of referrals we are currently receiving.

Baby Basics Newsletter:

Baby Basics Northampton continue to send out a Newsletter for the public and for referrals three times a year (January / April / September). Please see section 8. Newsletters for further information.

Baby Basics Manual:

We have created and maintain a Baby Basics Manual to explain and document our procedures and policy. This manual is updated yearly (August) to ensure any changes are amended accordingly.

Storage Space:

The team have been working with the storage space provided at the Kairos Centre. The Operations Team are considering using vacuum bags to store the clothing items to maximize the use of the space provided. The team is also liaising with Grange Park Church to try and secure some additional space within the Kairos Centre.

Further Development:

Baby Basics Northampton continues to work effectively and efficiently to continue to support and reach new mums in need in Northamptonshire.

The Operations Team will be looking for volunteers in due course. The team are currently liaising with Voluntary Impact Northampton who are assisting Baby Basics with ensuring all the relevant documentation, policies and procedures are in place before Baby Basics Northampton introduce volunteers.

Baby Basics Operation Team have been continuing to liaise with the Health Visitors, Midwives and Fire Service. The team has been instrumental in creating a partnership with the above bodies. It was agreed at a recent meeting that the Health Visitors and Midwives will make the Home Fire Safety Check referral on behalf of the mum to be to the Fire Service. A free Home Fire Safety Check is provided with each starter pack referral.



5. Words from Baby Basics Northampton Project Manager

Despite a lot of change in the last year, we have had an amazing year. With moving officially into the Kairos centre, a member of the team geographically relocating, becoming a charity, taking on trustees, changes in donation points, more and more referral agencies coming on board and building relationships with the fire service, churches and local community groups, the operational team have risen above and beyond the challenge.

The team were hugely boosted when the Northampton Community Foundation awarded us with the "Best Newcomers Award". This lead to increased press coverage and an appearance of the team on local radio! As well as some additional funding.

Referrals have increased both in numbers and in geographical area, and we have been truly blessed by the way donations have increased to meet demand. Procedures have been adapted to manage the increase, which have been very well received.

Donations have also increased and we would like to thank everyone who contributed to the project. This includes all our Facebook followers, everyone who donated via local giving, Julie Hedley and Julie Bainbridge for their sponsored events, all the knitting groups, craft groups, tot's groups, churches, schools, local groups, funders, local businesses and friends and family. Without you, none of this would be possible.

This year has been declared as "the year of the volunteer" and the operational team, with the help from VIN (Voluntary Impact Northampton), are working hard towards launching the volunteer initiative in September. We are looking forward to feeding back on its success.

Baby Basics Northampton

Welcome to the 4th Baby Basics Northampton Newsletter. This newsletter will provide further information about the work of Baby Basics Northampton along with all our exciting news and further information on our donation drop off points. We have had a busy few months, see overleaf for all our news!

What does Baby Basics Northampton do?

Baby Basics Northampton provides basic provisions to new vulnerable mums in Northamptonshire. These mums have little or nothing for their new baby and themselves.

Working with local health visitors, midwives, family workers, children centres and other agencies, starter packs filled with essential items for a newborn and their mum are distributed to those most at need.

Baby Basics provide: Moses Basket Starter Pack / Bath Starter Pack / Hospital Bags

Baby Basics can also provide microwave/cold water sterilisers and bottles. Baby Basics can also produce a starter pack to include early/tiny baby clothing and also smaller sized nappies (size 0).

How can I help Baby Basics Northampton?

Baby Basics Northampton could not send out the newborn starter packs to mums in need without the support of **YOU**. If you would like to help the work of Baby Basics Northampton, we can accept the following donated items:

- Moses Baskets (we cannot accept used moses basket mattresses)
- Moses basket sheets, blankets, towels, changing mats
- Girl, boy and neutral baby clothing (0-3 months, newborn, tiny/early baby) only
- Bibs, hats, mittens, baby shoes, muslins, baby sleeping bags
- Brand new toiletries for mum (shampoo, conditioner, shower gel, soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, tissues, breast pads, maternity/sanitary towels, comb, hair bands, hand wash)
- <u>Brand new</u> toiletries for baby (baby shampoo, baby bath, baby lotion, baby wash, baby toothbrush, baby toothpaste, cotton wool balls, nappy cream, nappies (size 0, 1 or 2), baby wipes, nappy sacks)
- Microwave/cold water steriliser, bottle brush (brand new), baby bottles (if used, teets to be removed), brand new packet of steriliser tablets
- Soft toy/toys suitable for newborn babies (no battery operated toys)

Please ensure all toiletries and nappies for mum and newborn baby are brand new.

Baby Basics cannot accept prams, cots/cot beds, breast pumps, car seats, electrical equipment or large toy items due to lack of storage facilities and/or health and safety consens.

Please note Baby Basics Northampton cannot pick up donations due to personal safety concerns.

Facebook

Facebook is a great point of contact for people who would like to donate to us or find out a little bit more about us. Our page has 2,673 likes (9th May 2017). By the time you read this it may have gone up.

Facebook is a great way to sign post people to the right direction for all sorts of things such as when we can't use what they would like to donate. We also have people contact us direct asking how they go about getting a basket. We have even had folks ask if they can buy them direct!


The most common questions that are asked is what sort of items we take and where our drop off points are. Even though these are pinned to the top of our page!

Generally speaking our posts are reaching anywhere from 900-4100 people, this can sometimes get higher. Most posts seem to engage folks quite well. The posts where we are asking for clothing will usually create a lot of messages and questions and can take up a lot of time. The posts that tend not to do too well are the ones where we ask for money either through sponsoring people who are doing an event to raise money for us or just generally asking people to donate.

I will only post once a day, possible twice, because any more than that we are in danger of making folks switch off or get irritated by posting too often.








Age of the mum to be:




