We initially focussed on carrying out projects in a pop up clinic, unfortunately this proved unsuccessful and we are now looking to work with hospitals in Nigeria on Sepsis guidelines.

Formation of new Trustee Board: Following the stepdown of a number of Trustee members, the charity has now worked to restructure and create a new trustee board, made up of a merge of the management board and trustee board. This came into effect in September 2018.
