Ministers' Report for 2017

2017 was another positive year in the life of Heath End Wesleyan Reform Church. Our Sunday services continued to be well attended with new members of the congregation joining throughout the year. We enjoyed welcoming one new person into full church membership and sadly marked the passing into glory of another long term member. Our membership numbers have remained at 24.

The major expenses of the church have been the installation of a new kitchen into the manse and the removal of the front wall at the church building. Both properties belonging to the church have been well maintained.

The usual ministries of the church have continued to be offered. These include: J Team children's group; 2 youth groups; Ladies Bible Study; Toddler Group; Keep Fit, TLC monthly ladies' group; monthly Friendship Group for retired people; church walks. Many volunteer hours are dedicated to running these activities which the church is very grateful for.

New and one-off activities of the church have included: Prayer 24; lent group; Maundy Thursday agape meal; men's ministry; Mission Group; ministry in the marketplace including listen and pray, mince pie giveaway and hot cross bun giveaway; quiz night; neighbourhood Christmas blessing; welcoming the Union President.

The Ministers have been involved in further activities including: assemblies, other supportive roles and governorship at Croft and Glendale schools; Nuneaton Foodbank; praying and working with other ministers from churches around the town; visiting Fredrick Warr care home; mentoring and supporting youth workers from the town; attending WRU conferences and meetings and ministering at Union churches.
