The charity has raised £42,311.06 from fundraising in the year. These funds together with surplus reserve brought forward facilitated in particular an opportunity for the school choir to have a recording session at a music studio and paid for the coaches to take the children on a variety of school trips during the year. We spent a total of £17,587.26 during the year, leaving reserves carried forward of £35,915.59. These funds will be spent in the following accounting period on various school related expenses
