### Trustees Report

The Trustees present their report and the accounts for the year ended 31 March 2018. The Financial Statements have been prepared in accordance with the Accounting policies stated on page 5 and comply with the applicable law.

### Public benefit

When reviewing the Charity's aims and objectives, measuring performance and planning future activities Trustees have had regard to the Charity Commission's guidance on public benefit.

### **Objectives**

- To continue with a rolling programme of repairs and refurbishment to the Centre.
- To help finance the upkeep of Golf Road Centre the hire charges are to be increased, when deemed appropriate, in line with inflation.
- To further enhance the play area for children with a wild life garden in the community accessible field nearby.
- To enter the South and South East in Bloom competition in the Small Parks Class in 2018.
- To establish, when fiscally viable, a North Deal Community Fund to assist in the well being of the local community.
- To become involved in and support the Dover District Council 'Loneliness' Community Initiative.

### Achievements and Performance

- Room hire raised by 2% without an appreciable loss of business.
- Room occupancy has continued to rise throughout the year.
- Repairs and refurbishment have continued throughout the year in line with the schedule drawn up.
- The play area is now open with the planting of the adjacent wild life area nearing completion. This has been achieved in partnership with local Government and significant input from volunteers.
- The North Deal Park was awarded certificates in the South and South East in Bloom competition in 2017. Due to this success the RHS judges suggested we enter the Small Parks Class for 2018.
- We are currently in the early stages of formulating plans in connection with the 'Loneliness' Project.

**Reserves Policy** 



A reserve policy has been formulated with monies being ring fenced for ongoing refurbishment and maintenance. A further amount has been set aside to cover any temporary closure and subsequent loss of income.
