B/ Structure, Governance and management

This is the first year of operation for this (Charitable Incorporated Organisation - CIO) charity formed in January 2017 which evolved from the activities of KiliEvents started by John Douglas in 2010. Wherever possible the charity seeks to have funds raised by its activities paid directly to those UK registered charities that it supports. This efficient method ensures swift distribution of funds and explains the relatively low income for Charity Links. To provide the *Independent Examination Report* the Trustees have been fortunate that Christopher Atkins ACA (retired) has kindly completed the Charity Commission form IER to support the accounts. The accounts are attached on the form CCXX R1/2.

C/ Objectives and Activities

From its inception Charity Adventure Links (CAL) set its sights on providing assistance to smaller UK charities working in the areas of children's education (both primary and secondary) and vocational training in Kenya, Rwanda, Tanzania & Uganda. The aim remains to help charities help themselves by arranging fundraising activities which the charities can 'adopt' and encourage their own supporters to participate in. The first such event in November 2017 was *Ride East Africa* in which seventeen cyclists collectively raised £44,000 for UK charities ## (see *Grants Awarded*- attached)

To widen the appeal of the events participants are permitted to support other UK registered charities provided at least 50% of the money raised goes to CAL nominated charities. Beneficiaries from Ride East Africa included two Hospices in Kent and a charity supporting Nepalese Sherpas.

While small charities have very pressing need for funds the organising of challenges such as CAL offers is however beyond the capability of their recourses. CAL is thus a 'facilitator' grouping charities with similar aims to benefit from creating an enlarged critical mass.

D/ Future Fundraising Activities

During 2019 & 2020 CAL plans to organise several cycle challenges in East Africa. To ensure maximum appeal the cycling will be restricted to eight days within one country however past experience has shown that several participants will extend their stay to allow time for other activities.
