# Independent examiner's report on the accounts

Report to the trustees/ members of Asperger London Area Group (ALAG) charity number 1160477 on accounts for the year ended 31 March 2018 set out on the preceding pages.

#### Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner

#### Basis of independent examiner's statement
