To advance support, develop and advance the lives of young and vulnerable people in the local community through:

- a. the provision of recreational and leisure time activities in the interests of social welfare;
- b. providing support and activities with the aim to develop their skills,

capabilities of our clients to enable them to participate in society confidently.

Through our partnership with the Brixton StreetGym we have engaged not young people in the community in Block Workout fitness sessions, which. Although the sessions are targeted to late teens to young adults, we have been successful in engaging other demographics in the local community. We have particularly targeted those who have been or are at risk a of being involved in crime and gang activity.

Through our qualified leaders we provide our clients with positive role models, who they can relate to.

We provide group and individual mentoring to participants, including promoting education, health living, conflict resolution and everyday issues that might arise.

We provide volunteer opportunities for young people and the wider community through our community Block Workout sessions.

Our work is currently focused on the Brixton area, but we have ambitions to extend our services to other parts of London and to partner with other organisations with similar focus.
