Report of the Trustees for the year ended 5 April 2018

Reference and administrative detail

The Westcroft Trust is a registered charity, number 212931. Its managing trustee is Mary C Cadbury, 32 Hampton Road, Oswestry, Shropshire SY11 1SJ.

Structure, governance and management

The Westcroft Trust is constituted by the trust deed dated 5 May 1947, as amended by deeds dated 31 December 1956 and 22nd September 1971. The trust funds are to be held upon trust to pay or apply the income and such parts of the capital thereof to or for such charitable institutions and charitable purposes as the trustees in their absolute discretion determine.

Recruitment and appointment of new trustees

The Trustees have considered the constitution of the Trust and decided that the existing arrangements are satisfactory to discharge current obligations, aims and objectives of the Trust.

A list of trustees is shown on the contents page to the accounts.

The training and induction provided for Trustees will depend on their existing experience. Where necessary induction will provide training on charity and financial matters, induction tends to be done informally and is tailored specifically to the individual.

Objectives and activities

The late Edward Cadbury, who founded the Trust in 1947, and was its Managing Trustee for 53 years, saw the giving of donations to charities in the following fields as an expression of his ideals and spiritual values. The present trustees hope to continue to support these areas of work.

In 2014 the Trustees conducted a review of the aims and objectives of the Trust. They resolved to move towards making fewer and larger grants and for shorter periods than in some cases in the past. By and large their areas of interest remain unchanged but have been divided into five main categories; Society of Friends (Quaker) activities across the UK; International understanding, peace and reconciliation and associated education and counselling; Social care and community development, particularly in Shropshire; International medical relief and aid; Disabilities and special needs, particularly in Shropshire.

We have referred to the guidance contained in the Charity Commission's general guidance on public benefit when reviewing our aim and objectives and in planning our future activities. In particular, the trustees consider how planned activities will contribute to the aims and objectives they have set.

Report of the Trustees; for the year ended 5 April 2018 (continued)

Achievements and performance

Total charitable donations in the year were £124,180 (2017 - £118,400).

The donations made from the Trust for the Religious Society of Friends totalled £26,480 which was 21.3% of total donations (2017 - £26,650, 22.5%).

Donations towards international understanding, peace, reconciliation, education and counselling totalled £33,000, 26.6% (2017 - £28,300 23.9%). Allocations to social care and community development, particularly in Shropshire, totalled £18,200, 14.7% (2017 - £10,050, 8.5%), and donations towards international medical and relief aid totalled £28,300, 22.8% (2017 - £31,100, 26.3%).

Amounts allocated to disabilities and special needs totalled £18,200, 14.6% (2017 - £22,300, 18.8%), of which £7,600 was allocated within Shropshire and £10,600 was allocated elsewhere in the UK.

Financial review

The net assets at 5 April 2018 were £2,487,689 (2017 - £2,576,572). These were represented mainly by investments managed by Brewin Dolphin Limited. The Trustees' policy on investments is to only derive income from ethical investments. In particular the trustees wish to avoid investment in the arms industry, in the production or sale of alcohol and tobacco and in companies which generate a substantial part of their profits from gambling.

The gross income for the year was £104,257 (2017 - £107,136). The fees payable to the Clerk to the Trustees, stockbrokers and accountants totalled £27,839 (2017 - £26,643). Investment management charges during the year were £19,057 (2017 - £18,150). The total net donations for the year were £124,180 (2017 - £118,400) resulting in a deficit for the year of £47,762 (2017 - £37,907). It remains the policy of the trustees to distribute the income of the Trust.

It is the practise of the Trustees to review well supported and large charities that they have supported in the past with particular regard to large balances that are revealed in the balance sheets.

Policy on reserves

The policy of the Trustees concerning reserves remains to distribute all the income derived from investments. The unrestricted funds of the charity as at 5 April 2018 are £2,487,689 (2017 - £2,576,572).

Notes to the Financial Statements for the year ended 5 April 2018

1 Accounting Policies

The Financial Statements have been prepared in accordance with applicable law and United Kingdom Accounting Standards (United Kingdom Generally Accepted Accounting Practice) and comply with the Statement of Recommended Practice (SORP) Accounting and Reporting by Charities FRS102 effective from January 2015. The Financial Statements are prepared under the historic cost convention.

Judgements in applying accounting policies and key sources of estimation uncertainty

In preparing these Financial Statements, the Trustees and Directors have made judgements, the details of which are included in the following accounting policies.

Investments

The listed investments are revalued annually to market value. Gains or losses on investments sold during the year are calculated by reference to the market value at the beginning of the year or subsequent cost. The unrealised and realised gains and losses for the year are included in the statement of financial activities.

Incoming resources

Investment income is included in the accounts on a receivable basis.

Resources expended

Expenditure has been charged to the statement of financial activities on an accruals basis.

Direct charitable expenditure relates to the donations made in the year. Donations payable are payments made to third parties in the furtherance of the charitable objectives of the Trust.

Governance costs include those costs associated with meeting the constitutional and statutory requirements of the charity and include the audit fees and costs linked to the management of the charity.
