It provides a base from which Christian and community groups and charities function. These include the Wesley Chapel Methodist congregation, Presence Church, Harrogate Homeless Project, Town Pastors, Hope Church, Green Pastures, Lifeline and Wesley Concerts, as well as good working relationships with groups such as Supporting Older People, Spa Ladies, Mencap and Harrogate International Festival. The key vulnerability in this respect is that approximately 40% of our income comes from one tenancy. The deficit in the year and the predicted one for 2018/19 means that the current reserve is considered adequate for the present but might need to be reviewed if any further major repair work on any of our buildings is required. Other sources of funding are being considered.
