Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the year Garw Valley Links continues to lease a shop called 'His Place' in Pontycymmer, Bridgend.

The Pontycymer Foodbank, operating in 'His Place', was open two days a week. 283 food vouchers were received in 2018, providing 3 days of food for 725 people (489 adults and 236 children). Donated clothes were also available free of charge at 'His Place', which was also used regularly as a drop in centre.

Regular church services have continued on Sunday mornings in 'His Place' in Pontycymmer. The evening service continued to be held in Blaengarw. Special events were held at Easter and Christmas which included free teas open to everyone.

There were also visits to a nursing home and other community venues. Regular ladies and men's meetings were held throughout the year.

A link with New Wine Cymru has enabled the church to be involved in a national and local missions in 2018.

Continued support has been given to works that the charity is linked with internationally.
