Treasurer's Report

to the Accounts for the year ended 31/08/18

St Michael's Parents & Friends Association has had another successful year.

A number of fundraising events were held providing a total surplus of £7226.39. The most successful fundraiser was by far the Spring Ball that generated a substantial profit of £10,352.52 with £10,561.53 being paid to West Kent Mind.

Other successful events were as follows:

- £3104.21 Christmas Bazaar
- £1281.08 Sports Days / Camp Out
- £796.50 Christmas Card Project
- £506.00 Panto
- £428.82 Comedy Night
- £5.00 Cheese & Wine

A further £5,995 was received from subscriptions, and £120.18 from Easy Fundraising.

This year the P & F have purchased the following items:

- £329 Dishwasher for the Pavilion
- £466 Mugs for the Pavilion
- £204 Plaque formPrep Garden
- £3500 Piano Fund
- £548 Basketball Rings
- £2500 Pre Prep Slide
- £1330 Gazebo
- £1995 Sensory Equipment
- £2363 Pre Prep Mural

In addition to distribution of funds to the school, contributions were also made towards leavers parties for Years 2, 6 & 8, (this remained at £10 per child), Easter eggs, and Christmas Trees.

All this resulted in an increase of the cash balance to £53692.60

The accounts for the financial year ending 31 August 2018 have been independently reviewed and will be filed with the Charity Commission by 30th June 2019.

Our new online bank account has made receiving and paying money much easier, and the School allowing us to add events onto school fees has both eased the processing and increased the uptake on events.

Since the start of this academic year, a profit of £4202.00 was generated by the Christmas Bazaar. A further £101.20 was raised through the Panto. This year's Christmas Card Project raised a further £306.50.

I would like to take this opportunity to say a huge thank you for the successful hard work and support of Sadie West, Claire Soper and Charlotte Parkinson over the last few years as they all step down from their roles as Co Chairs and Secretary. I would also like to welcome Oliver Schneider as the new Chair along with Anna-Marie Mottram as our new Secretary and Jo Pennington-Leigh as a Committee Member.

A special thank you also needs to be made to Suzanne Clapham and the Spring Ball team for their hard work and their success in raising over $\pm 10,000$ for charity and the P & F.

A further thank you goes to Jules Benjamin for her hard work in organising the Christmas Bazaar and will now be stepping down from this role.

INDEPENDENT EXAMINATION

Charities with a gross income of £1m or less may choose to have an independent examination in place of an audit unless both their gross assets exceed £3.26m and their gross income exceeds £250,000.

As requested, Kim Christen and I have reviewed the accounting records kept by the Parents and Friends Association and compared the accounts presented with those records.

Please be aware that we have not carried out a professional audit but during our scrutiny of the records, we have not found any material misstatement or omission.

We would like to make the following suggestions for your consideration:

- Change the address on the Barclays Bank statements to the school address and the statements can be collected from here. This allows for continuity when there is an appointment of a new Treasurer.
- Provide a set of P & F Minutes for the examiner relating to the meetings held during the year to evidence agreement to make purchases of items for the school.

We will approach the members of the Finance Committee to see if anyone is able to do the independent examination going forward.
