Whitchurch Sports Junior Football Club – Charity Number 1163791 Report of the trustees for the year ending June 30th 2018

The trustees of the Whitchurch Sports Junior Football Club present their annual report and audited accounts for the year ended 30th June 2018 and confirm they comply with the requirements of the Charities Act 2011, the club constitution and the Charities SORP (FRS 102).

<u>Our Aims</u>

The club operates under a Club Constitution & Rules approved by the Charity Commission on the 30th September 2015.

The Objectives of the club are;

(a) to advance the amateur sport of association football.

(b) to promote community participation in healthy recreation by providing facilities for playing association football (facilities means land, buildings, equipment and organising football activities).

(c) to provide and assist in providing facilities for sport, recreation and other leisure time occupation of people who have need of such facilities because of their youth, age, infirmity or disablement, poverty or

social and economic circumstances or for the public at large in the interests of social welfare and with the object of improving their conditions of life.

(d) to advance the education of children and young people whether or not undergoing formal education.

Review of Activities and Achievements

Finances

Net cash flow of (-£2,768.48) reported to go into the 2018/19 season. The decrease is due to the club funding of the 40th Anniversary event & new goals. The summer tournament was the main source of income and once again the success was due to a dry warm weekend. This has a level of risk associated to it due to being weather dependent.

The Club processed its first gift aid claim with the 2017/18 subscription income £2019.68. Further claims under 'small' donations eligibility (Tournament parking, bag packing, fund raisers) will now be eligible to compiled and claims from the 2018/19 subscription will now continue to progress. This being a key source of income for the club.

Club membership

Club membership increased again for the season 2017-18 with the continued growth of the boys U7's now participating in a registered playing league (SFA Hanham Minor League). The girls team has continued to grow now proudly offering 8 teams from U8's developing to U 16. The club continues to offer U18's for Boys ensuring the foundations of the full player pathway experience from Mini, Junior to Adult under the Whitchurch Club. The Girls U18's has regrettably folded due to the Somerset FA ruling that the club could not alternatively register this team under the Gloucester FA. This request was from the players & parents who were unable to continue manage the game travelling time. A compelling case was presented by the club demonstrating the significantly reduced travelling time. The ruling was taken on appeal to the national FA but regrettably for the club & players, the decision was upheld.

Coaching affiliation & progression continues to be a priority and funded and supported by the club.

Disability team - (Dragons)

The club continues to lead the way in providing disability football. The Dragons team is now secure in its 3rd year and the Adults disability team is flourishing and able to concentrate on its members and playing football with the club supporting and managing its affiliations and finances. The club prides itself on offering the full Football Club experience with no discrimination and interaction with mainstream society.

Achievements & Support

The club was unable to secure a Tournament sponsor.

FA Mentor – Dan Right a FA Level UEFA B coach continues to be assigned to the Whitchurch JFC club by the Somerset FA as a mentor to help develop our managers coaching skills. Fantastic recognition & support by the Somerset FA of the clubs continued commitment to deliver high quality football to all boys & girls.
