Eventually Sight Cwmru agreed to take over. We therefore provided them with enough equipment to provide a full service, and to keep going for a year. The transfer took place in the summer and was an immediate success.

Similarly we transferred the operations of the Stevenage TN to local volunteers, again successfully.

Raising funds in excess of £30000 was very difficult, but we did it. Now that Gwent and Stevenage have gone, managing the Lichfield TN will be very much easier.

There are no plans to start any new Talking Newspapers in the immediate future, thius we should have a year to consolidate.
