Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the year	This year we have continued to support the school's rolling programme of refurbishment, agreeing funding for a complete upgrade to the Da Vinci suite, including seating areas for IT work, quiet reading and small group work. This expenditure will be reflected in next year's accounts.
	In addition, we have supported the purchase of a range of resources for use across the whole school, including £5,222 contribution to the leasing costs of the 16 Clevertouch screens and £2,325 for new staging in the hall allowing more opportunities for school plays, music and other concerts. We have also funded new sports and science equipment.
	The PTA continues to fund the purchase of a home school booklet for every child to track and record reading and homework, as well as enabling parents to become fully involved in their child's learning.
