An additional allowance may be made for the Musical Director and the Assistant Musical Director or Accompanist for attendance at rehearsals and for participation in performances and concerts.
- 9.6 The Society shall receive membership subscriptions, donations, grants in aid and financial guarantees. Tickets for any or all of its concerts and other events shall be offered for sale to the public.
- 9.7 The income and property of the Society whencesoever derived shall be applied solely towards promoting the Objects of the Society as set forth above and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred either directly or indirectly to any Member or Members of the Society except in payment of legitimate expenses incurred on behalf of the Society.
